



Phaedra Gale Boothe

January 30, 1971 - April 6, 2014

A spirit of light and hope, Phaedra Boothe, joined her eternal family on April 6th. Born in Lubbock January 30, 1971, Phaedra lived most of her life in Lubbock. She lived in Santa Fe, Taos, Los Angeles and Aspen for most of the 1990s.

Phaedra graduated from Lubbock High School in 1989. She obtained her cosmetology license in 2003. After working at the Bijou for 8 years, Phaedra became her own boss, working for herself most recently at Salon Sculpt. From the time she could walk, Phaedra's athleticism was apparent. She played soccer from the time she was 6 years old until graduating from high school. During her three years playing goalie for Lubbock High School, Phaedra was never scored upon. Concurrently with her pursuit of soccer, she played slow-pitch softball for nationally ranked Lampe Green. She was a pitcher, a first base player and homerun hitter. Phaedra was an avid skier. While living in New Mexico and Colorado, she was able to pursue her passion for powder every winter. More recently, Phaedra skated Roller Derby for the West Texas Roller Dolls under the moniker Cool Rockin' Rolleta. Her friends and fans called her Ro or Ro Ro.

Throughout her life, Phaedra supported live music and the arts. As a natural outgrowth of her love of music, she began following the Grateful Dead in the 1990s. She traveled all over the US to see shows. After Jerry Garcia's death in 1995, she began to follow various bands led by Bob Weir and Phil Lesh, including Further, Ratdog and others. She had friends from all over the US

and several in other countries through the Deadhead community. Our Phaedra should have had wings. It would have saved her so much money in air fare and car rentals!

Phaedra worked very hard and was a successful hairstylist. It was almost impossible to be around her for long before she was playing with your hair and giving you tips on how to style it. Phaedra also played very hard. Phaedra was generous to a fault, with her time, her artistry and her money. She was who she was: authentically, unapologetically and lovingly. We have only begun to feel the impact of her passing.

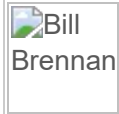

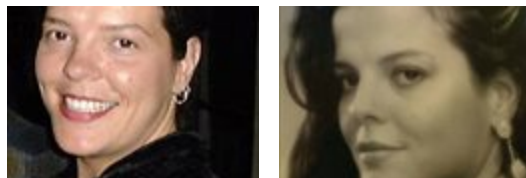
