Rebecca "Becky" Louise Cleveland slipped peacefully away from us on February 6, 2013 in the arms of her family at her home in Lubbock. Funeral services will be held February 9, 2013 at 1:00 pm at Holy Spirit Catholic Church with burial at Peaceful Gardens Memorial Park in Woodrow, Texas.
