Rex Powell Fuller, age 74, of Lubbock, died peacefully Saturday evening, Oct. 13, 2018. A lifelong Lubbock resident, he was the son the late R.P. (Bob) Fuller and Lloyd Elaine Riley Fuller.

Rex was a respected member of the local community who spent his career working in the oil and gas industry. He served as director and national affairs chairman of the Texas Independent Producers & Royalty Owners (TIPRO). He held the same positions for the Independent Petroleum Association of America, and testified before the United States House Energy and Commerce Committee on behalf independent producers. Rex was a president of the Panhandle Producers and Royalty Owners Association, as well as a member of the Texas Railroad Commission advisory board on gas production.

Rex served on the Board of Regents at Texas Tech University from 1981-1993. A Lubbock High School graduate, he earned a bachelor's degree from Texas Tech University in business administration and graduated from the Executive Program at Stanford University. He was active in local civic and volunteer organizations, and a lifelong member of First United Methodist Church of Lubbock, where he served as board director and ushered for 50 years.

Rex is survived by his loving wife of 48 years, Gloria Martin Fuller; along with three children and their partners: Robert Fuller and Cathryn Gabor of Houston; Amy and John Bennett of Washington, D.C.; and Ryan and Diane Fuller of Melrose, Mass.; two grandchildren: Elliana Rae Fuller and Riley

Patrick Fuller; as well as many loving relatives and friends. He was preceded in death by a baby boy and his sister, Ann Fuller.

A memorial service for Rex Fuller will be held at 2 p.m., Wednesday, Oct. 17, 2018, at First United Methodist Church of Lubbock.
