Robert Samuel Renfro (Bob) of Lubbock passed away on May 28, 2017. Bob was born in Wichita Falls, Texas on March 31, 1927. He graduated from Wichita Falls High School and Hardin Simmons University and received his master's degree from West Texas State University. Bob was a WWII Navy veteran.

Bob moved to Lubbock in 1955 where he was associated with the family business of McCarty Renfro Tobacco Company until 1964. Bob then began his teaching career. He taught English, speech, and drama until his retirement from Seagraves ISD in 1986. He was a Rotary Paul Harris Fellow. He enjoyed traveling the world with his family, playing bridge, and volunteering at the Food Bank; but most of all, he enjoyed supporting his "perfect" grandchildren. He was an active member of First Christian Church, serving as a deacon.
