Rowena Grisham Walker, 92, passed away on Friday, September 15, 2017 at Carriage Inn in Bryan, Texas.

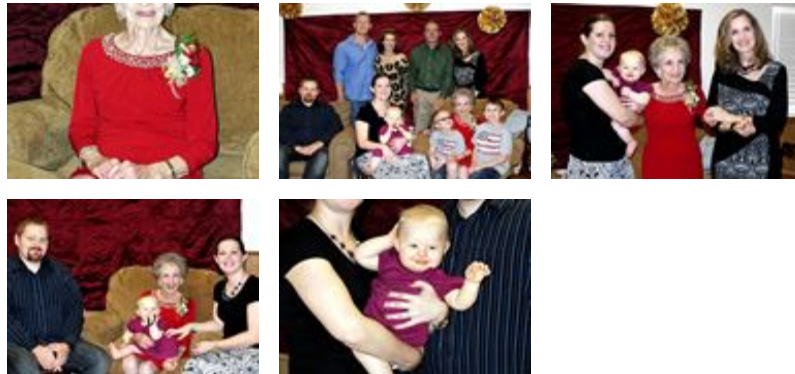
