Ruston "Russ" Craig Swim went to be with his Lord and Savior on Monday, November 6, 2017. He was 50 years old. He was born in Landstuhl, Germany, March 30, 1967 to Sam and Wanda Swim. Russ graduated from Coronado High School and attended The University of Texas in Austin. He began his career at an early age, bussing tables at a restaurant and through hard work and a dedication to excellence, soon worked his way up the ladder to manager. He next worked as a food broker for several food brokers before opening his own brokerage business. He received many awards connected with his occupation, including Broker of the Year Award, five years in a row, from Sysco West Texas, Inc, the largest food distribution company in West Texas. He sold his business to Acosta, the largest food service in the nation and was retained as National Vice President of Sales Operations at Acosta. Russ was very proud of his accomplishments.
