Sheri Lynn (Scott) Gicklhorn, age 67, passed away peacefully in her home on October 17, 2020. Graveside to be held October, 26th 2020 at Green Memorial Cemetery in Wilson, TX at 1:00 PM with Minister Laredo Shannon officiating. Sheri was born in Lubbock, TX on September 19, 1953 to Hardy T. Scott and Louise (Lou) Scott. She graduated from Coronado High School and went to Texas Tech University where she played French Horn in Goin' Band from Raiderland and the Texas Tech Orchestra. She held various jobs through the years but was mostly known for her unwavering service to her community through 4-H and her church (Hearts Together Church of Christ) in Slaton, TX. Her impact is surely felt throughout the state of Texas in which she mentored and led a multitude of young people to become the future leaders of their communities. She routinely fed numerous families through her church's Mary and Martha ministry as well as Meals on Wheels. Her love for her Lord, her faith, her family, and the people she met shined through in anyone who was fortunate to know her.

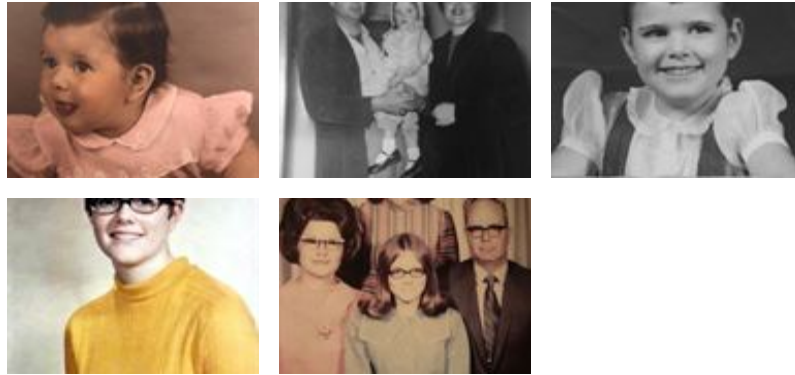
