Memorials may be made to the pet rescue of your choice in the name of Stephanie. A memorial service will be scheduled at a later date.

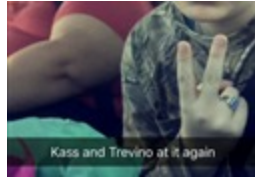
