It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Steve Carson, a beloved husband, father, brother, and grandfather, who left this world peacefully on January 8, 2026. Born in Mt Vernon, Illinois, on November 30, 1944, he lived a life filled with love, dedication, and service. He married his wife Teddy on March 21st, 1963.
