January 29, 1935 - April 17, 2013

Tommy "Pop" Modisette, 78, of Lubbock passed away on Wednesday, April 17, 2013 at his residence in Lubbock. He was born January 29, 1935 in Kiowa, Oklahoma to Sam & Adina Modisette.

He moved to O'Donnell, Texas in 1938. He served in the United States Army in Fort Lewis from 1958 until 1960 and in Fort Polk from 1961 until 1962.

Tommy retired from the USPS in 2001 after 25 years of service. He married Theresa Estes on November 28, 1986. Tommy was a member of the First United Methodist Church in O'Donnell.

He is preceded in death by his wife; a son; brother; and parents.

Survivors include three sons, Tony of Big Spring, Bennett of Idalou, and Lance of Lubbock; 14 grandchildren; and two great grandchildren.

Services will be at 10:00 a.m., Monday, April 22, 2013 at Sanders Memorial Chapel with Rev. Jim Irwin officiating. Interment will follow at Peaceful Gardens Memorial Park under the direction of Sanders Funeral Home.
