What gives me peace in accepting Yvonne's passing is the fact that she is in God's Kingdom, no longer suffering at all, knowing that one day, we will see her once again. While she is gone physically from this earth and this life as we know it, she will continue to live on in

the hearts of her children, grandchildren, and their children. What a blessing we have all been given in having Yvonne in our lives, for each and every one of us have been made better by this remarkable and loving woman.
