November 17, 1930 - July 28, 2023

Zoda Grace Boatman Wooten, 92, of Abernathy, Texas went to her Heavenly homecoming July 28th, 2023.

Grace was born November 17th, 1930, in Turkey, Texas to Robert and Zoda Boatman. Grace was called into ministry in her early teens, traveling and holding revivals in the West Texas area. Grace attended Southwestern Bible College where she met her husband JW Weldon Wooten. She completed her bachelor's degree in education at Texas Tech University and taught 1st grade for 15 years while continuing her ministry. Grace also enjoyed preaching on a radio program in West Texas. While raising 3 children she pastored in Crosbyton and then Littlefield for 10 years. Grace then traveled to Wilmington, Delaware where she pastored at Kings Assembly of God Church for several years. The last church that she co-pastored was 1st Assembly of God in Abernathy, TX for 24 years. Grace was an artist, poet, musician, gifted Bible Teacher, student of God's Word, and an inspiring Preacher. She radiated love to all who knew her.

She is survived by son Johnny Weldon Wooten (Jenise) of Lubbock, TX, daughter Jan Diane Wooten Weinacht (Paul) of Newark, DE, and daughter Judy Darlene Wooten of Abernathy, TX; daughter-in-heart Johnnia Harrell; granddaughter Grace Suzanne Wooten, two grandsons Christopher Paul and Michael Joseph Weinacht; and four great-grandchildren.

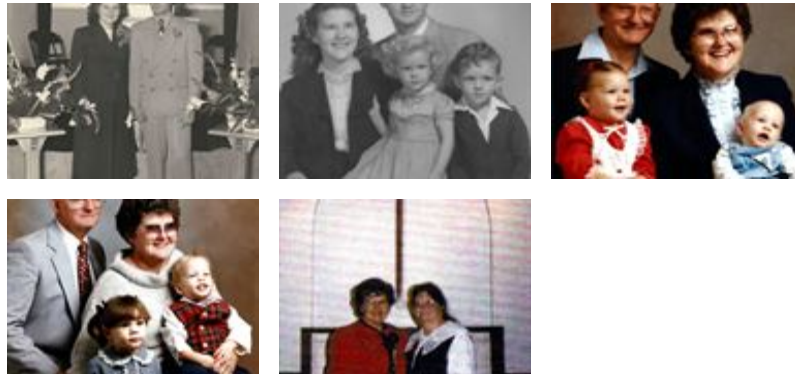

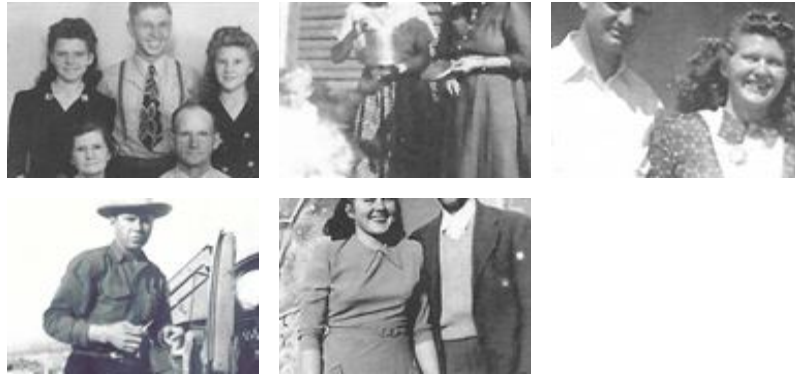
